## Traveling to Educo

### **Plan to arrive at the site:**

- Summer Programs between 2pm and 4pm
- Adult Programs between 6:30pm and 7:30pm
- Family Programs between 6:30pm and 8pm
- Clean Up Weekends anytime after 7:30pm

### **Driving from the Lower Mainland to 100 Mile House**

Travel East on the Trans-Canada Highway #1 to Hope. From Hope travel north on Highway 97 through the Fraser Canyon to Cache Creek and then on to 100 Mile House. Travel time is approximately 6 hours.

### **Driving from 100 Mile House to Educo Site**

Once in 100 Mile House, turn west on Exeter Station Road (4th stoplight if you are coming from the south and 1st stoplight as you enter town from the north). Follow this road over the railway tracks where you turn left and go up the hill onto the gravel road. Slight left at the top of the hill and follow this road straight over the cattle guard. You are now on the 1100 road and will begin to see signs marking the kilometers (11-01, 11-08, etc.). Stay on this main logging road until you pass the 11-14 marker. A few hundred meters past the 11-14 marker. Once you will come to the Educo driveway on your left. Follow it to the site. You have arrived!
